Key words

Detached	A house that is not joined to any other houses.
Semi-Detached	A house that is joined to another house by one wall.
Terraced	A row of similar houses joined together.

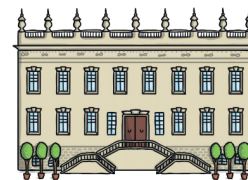
