Key words

Significant person

An important person in History who has discovered or invented something.

Disease

A condition that causes harm to the health of a person.

Crimean War

A war fought between Russia on one side, and France, Turkey and the UK on the other side.

Nurse

A person who is trained to care for sick or injured people and who usually works in a hospital or doctor's office



Florence Nightingale became a nurse and helped soldier who were hurt in the war.

Florence was asked to take a team of nurses to a hospital in Scutari to help soldiers who were injured in the Crimean war.

She got the name 'The Lady with the Lamp' because she would visit soldiers at night with a small lantern in her hand.
