## Key Vocabulary

Organisms	Living things.
Life processes	The things living things do to stay alive.
Habitat	The specific area or place in which particular animals or plants may live.
Environment	This contains many habitats and these include areas where there are both living and non-living things.
Endangered species	A plant or animal which has not many of their species left and scientists are concerned.
Extinct	When a species has no more members alive on the planet.
Classification	When plants and animals are placed into groups according to their similarities.
