### GREAT FIRE OF LONDON

- Research Samuel Pepys, the great fire or King Charles II in more detail
- Visit London and record in photos! Pudding Lane, The Monument and Museum of London are all fantastic

- Build a model of a timber-framed house from 1666 London
- Create some fire-inspired artworks of your own, using paint, chalk/pastel or the art packages on Purple Mash



### HEALTHY LIFESTYLES

- Draw a diagram of a yourself, labelling ways in which you can keep yourself fit and healthy
- Make an information leaflet on diet, healthy eating, hygiene or sleep

- Prepare a healthy meal. Record your progress with photos and explain your choice of ingredients
- Write a report on a long walk, a bike ride, a sport or fitness activity



### AT THE FARM

- Research a food item and find out how it gets from farm to shop
- Make an 'I spy' book of farm vehicles
- Research different kinds of farm

- Create a model of a farm
- Visit a farm or take a footpath nearby: write about what you see
- Visit a library to find a story set on a farm. Draw and write about it
